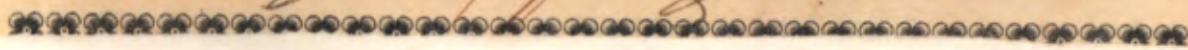
And the said *J. S. Alder* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it:

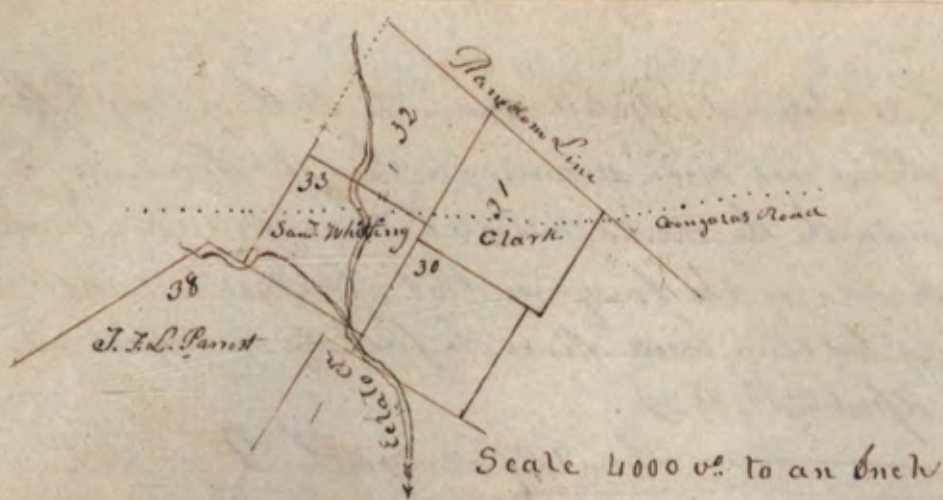
