This is to certify that Joseph Worsham has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Montgomery, and provided according to Law that he arrived in this County in 1835

and that he is a single man and entitled to One third of a League of land upon the condition of paying at the rate of Three $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars for every labor of Inhabitable land Two $\frac{50}{100}$ dollars for every labor of Temporal or Arable land and One $\frac{40}{100}$ dollar for every labor of Pasture land which may be contained in the survey secured to said Worsham by this certificate given under our hands

this the 8th day of February 1838
