for each labor of Temporal or arable land *One Dollar and twenty Cents*

for every labor of Pasture land which may be contained in the survey secured to *Him*

by this Certificate.

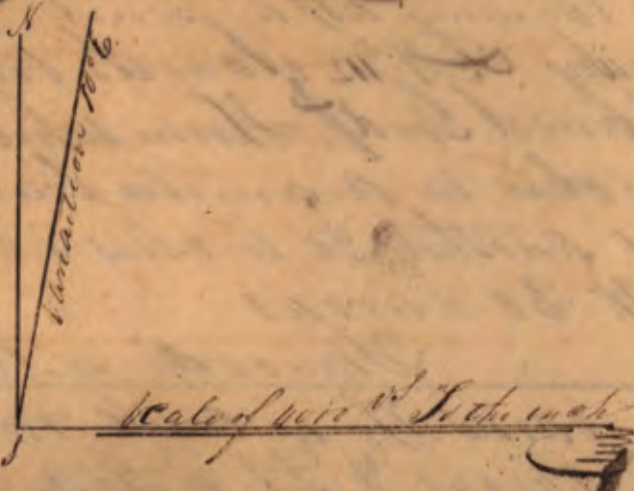
